Range:

Six weeks, a total of 60 hours of study (video conferencing, tutorials, self-study, projects ...)

Number of 2 ECTS credits (student must complete both compulsory and at least 2 optional courses).

Modules required:

- Intercultural Studies 15 hours
- Czech language 15 hours

Modules selectable 15 hours (minimum of 2 options must be selected, maximum is unlimited):

- Fundamentals of Marketing
- Technologies for WEB Publishing
- Ontologies and Semantic WEB
- Business Economics and Basics of Finance
- Introduction in law
- Ready to Talk?
- Complex systems
- Networks

Form:

The program will consist of the module Intercultural studies (information about the Czech Republic and European culture - 12 hours) and several other modules that the student will be able to choose. The range of one module is 12, max. 24 hours of self-study. Individual modules will be supplemented by 2 video tutorials (introductory and final). In the case of larger modules, there may be another video tutorial in progress.
